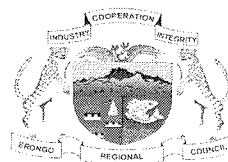

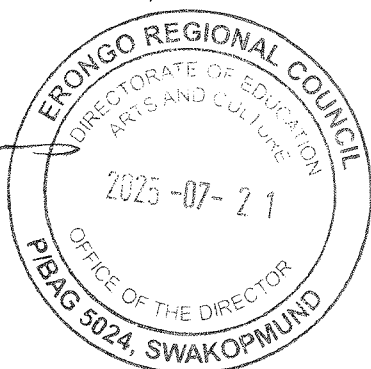
### FINAL ARRANGEMENTS AND SCHEDULE FOR ERONGO REGIONAL ANNUAL CAREER FAIR ROAD-SHOW – 23 TO 25 JULY 2025 – SWAKOPMUND, WALVISBAY AND OMARURU

1. This year, we again secured the presence of a wide variety of Career Exhibitors, while we have an exciting line-up of presentations from a variety of speakers. The Career Fair will be a Road Show starting from 23 July in Omaruru, 24 July in Walvis Bay, and 25 July in Swakopmund. The final program will be sent to the schools by tomorrow 22 July 2025.
2. Please note that we would like the parents to attend the event and will rely on your support to spread the message amongst the parents. *Please see attached, invitation to the parents.*
3. *Attached*, also find the transportation schedule (Annexure A) with details of the pick-up and drop-off times, the dates and the school names, for schools who requested for transport.
4. Transport arrangements were made only for schools located in the remote areas outside of the above-mentioned towns where the Career Fair event will take place. However, schools located in the towns where the event will be held should make their own transport arrangements to get the learners to the venue and back.
5. Each school should provide the learners with a morning sandwich or snack to eat on the road to the event, and the lunch pack/meal will be provided at the venue by the Directorate of Education, Innovation, Youth, Sports, Arts and Culture.
6. Upon arrival, your group will be given a short orientation of the venue and program. It is therefore vital that you **report to the reception area** as soon as your school arrives at the venue and for the focal teacher to sign in for attendance. You may contact the Regional School Counsellor, Ms. Yvonne Tjerivanga at 0814779986, to announce your arrival, should the reception area not be manned at any specific time.
7. All school groups **must** be accompanied by a teacher(s) from the school, preferably the Life Skills Teacher(s), since they also have to collect materials for their life skills classes.
8. Each learner must bring along either a pen or pencil and some note pads to take notes. The exhibitors will be informed to provide each school with information packs to take with to the school, for further career guidance.
